Volunteer Galway - What We Can Do For You!

Established in 2006, Volunteer Galway provides a quality user-friendly service to members of the public and voluntary groups, covering Galway City and County. Based at 27 William Street West, our support service aims to increase access to positive volunteering for the public and for volunteer involving organisations.

At Volunteer Galway anyone interested in volunteering can access information without having to make a commitment. Our service can be accessed online or by making an appointment. Organisations can advertise their volunteer roles on our regularly updated website and, once registered, will receive dedicated support from staff on how their recruitment is going for every role that they advertise. Anyone signed up to our vetting service will receive training and support from staff in how to use the service and go about vetting volunteers involved in their organisation.

Our Community Events Calendar is a free resource for anyone in the community looking to find out what is going on in Galway. Anyone hosting a community event can register their

event on our calendar, where it can be viewed by people coming to our website. At Volunteer Galway our staff can offer their expertise in the many aspects of volunteer management through our training and consultancy service. We are now offering training and networking opportunities through our community excellence network for non-profit organisations to support them to grow and be even more successful.

Volunteering can help improve self-esteem, combat social isolation and enhance recovery from mental health difficulties. Our Flourish service offers confidential one-to-one support to anyone experiencing a mental health challenge who would like to volunteer to aid their recovery. We also organise Community Excellence Gatherings to help organisations to network and find out about services that they can avail of to build strong and sustainable organisations.
